## Directions

1. Cut out your pieces as follows

Print: $28-21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Solid: $1-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
2- $1 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips
$2-1 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips
2. Sew your prints together as follows

2 - 3 block strips
2-4 block strips
2-6 block strips
3. Begin by sewing your two single prints to the white square. Then sew your two 3 block strips to the top and bottom of this strips to create your first square of patchwork.
4. Sew the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61_{2}^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the side of your patchwork square. Sew the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the top and bottom of your patchwork square. Square up if needed.
5. Sew the two 4 block strips to the sides of your patchwork square. Then sew your 6 block strips to the top and bottom. Square up if needed
