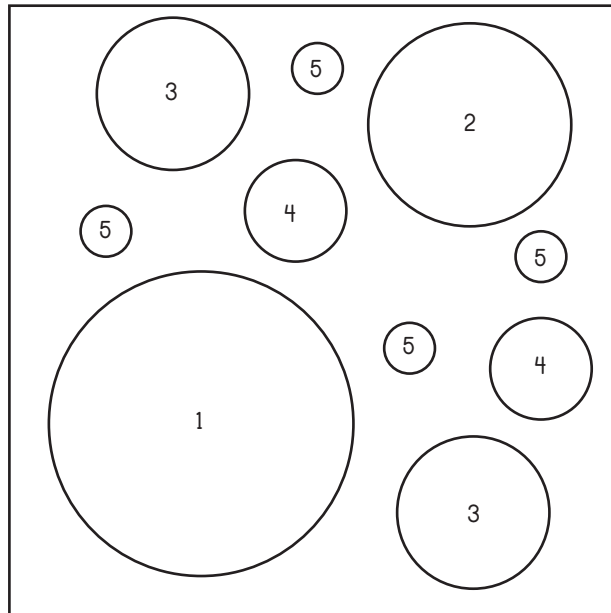


Reverse Applique Circles



Directions

1. Cut the following (or grab scraps from your scrap bin in roughly the same size)
 - Solid: 1 - 12½" x 12½" square
 - Prints: 1 - 6½" square
 - 1 - 4½" square
 - 2 - 3½" squares
 - 2 - 2½" squares
 - 4 - 1½" squares
2. Trace the circles onto the front of your 12½ x 12½" square using the attached templates.
3. Working with your 12½" square right side up, lay the appropriately sized print behind it's designated circle, print side face up and against the back of the 12½" square.
4. Working from the front of the large square, begin top stitching around your drawn circle. Continue around your circle two more times, making sure you are stitching your print to the solid square.
5. Flip your block over and trim away the excess print to roughly a ¼" from your sewn circle edge. Repeat the previous steps for all circles.
6. After all the circles are sewn down, clip away the solid fabric insides the sewn circles. This will reveal your print. Make sure to leave a small amount of the solid fabric as you clip away near your threads. You may choose to use fray check around the edges of your circle, or leave it raw to fray with time.
